Dear Sisters in Christ,

Oh dear, I have been sitting and reading the last two years of articles written by the past Spiritual Directors, so centered, so holy, and selfless. I feel a bit overwhelmed and out of my league.

So, I will start with a prayer. Father God, I have no idea what I am to say to all these wonderful woman who love you so much. Please place upon my heart the words, ideas, or thoughts you would have me share. May your will be done not mine. Amen

For the last few years I have been working with another group, volunteering my time and gifts as needed. I have worked out of our country traveling to very poor areas to either help build homes or to fit people for eye glasses. It is such a thrill to witness a grandmother see her grandchild's face for the first time clearly. However, this work took me from my family for long periods of time and was also very physically demanding. So, I prayed. "God, my family needs me here, but I want to serve you. I am open to any form of work you have for me. Amen." The next day the phone rang and here I am.

When the call came and I was invited to return to Whispering Winds, to join the board, and to be the Spiritual Director my first reaction was, "No!
