

My friend Norman died in 2019 at 87. He was truly a walking embodiment of Christ. Norman had a checkered past to put it mildly.

One day he was working in a field when he heard a voice, "Norman, you are sick go and see a priest." Norman was not churched nor was he a spiritual man. But, he immediately laid down his shovel and drove to the one Catholic Church in the small burg where he lived and knocked on the rectory door. When the door opened, he told the priest what had just happened, and was invited into the Church.

Norman put his hand out to everyone he met. He always smiled, even though smiling did not come easily to him, asked the person for their name and told them his. He would then linger a moment to see if a conversation might get started up. His Christian life was simple. He was present to those that he met. His listened and he took action when needed. That was really all he did. He carried around 3 by 5 cards and wrote notes to himself: people's name, who he wanted to pray for, lunch dates. Again, all simple tasks that were centered around others.

There were a number of us that he mentored. He would meet me for lunch monthly and we would talk about living life on life's terms. Sometimes, he would call me with a problem and we would talk and pray about it. It was a wonderful relationship and I miss him dearly.

I share my sweet memories of Norman with you to perhaps inspired you to slow down and do the simple actions for others that can so represent the face of our Lord smiling at them. Sometimes, I can get so rushed that I forget to be polite, to smile, and give back. But, I know that I can not operate from my feelings. I know that ministry is a decision based on my calling from God and not on how I am feeling on any certain day. So with that, I sit doing my best to share with you today. Taking my feelings and list of chores and folding them into myself, like a swan closes her wings, so I might say YES to Whispering Winds. I know that when I do what is in front of me there will also be time to take the next step. Things have a way of working themselves out. But sometimes its hard to act on that knowledge, that lived experience. But, when I do, like Norman, I sometimes find that I am blessed to be the face of God for someone in that moment.

So, if you are like me and you are feeling called to give back to Whispering Winds, but you are not sure what action to take, just pick up the phone and call our new president, Nelda McComb. Think of Norman, how he lived his

life one step at a time and in so doing found time to work, be a husband and dad, a great friend and bring God to his community. The question I ask myself is can I be like Norman? The answer is YES and so can you!

Judy's family lives in San Diego, Winterport, Maine, and in the Bay Park neighborhood, near Oakland, CA.

Judy's life journey has lead her, and her family, from San Diego, to Bakersfield, Salt Lake City, back to San Diego, up to Seattle and back to San Diego once again.

She remained close to God through the Charismatic Movement, was a member of the Association of Christian Therapists, prayed with patients in medical settings and came to know Whispering Winds through her dear friend, Jean E. Taddonio.

During her time auditing Worker's Comp claims at a major company, she implemented processes that saved the company \$22 million in her first year on the staff. She also developed a drug free work place program that became a company standard.

Judy's Irish and Italian parents were the first in their families to marry outside their clans.

According to Italian tradition, Judy was supposed to be named Adeline Rose, in honor of her Father's Mother and oldest Sister. Her Irish Mother went against that tradition and decided to name their first-born child Judy, in honor of St. Jude—the Patron Saint of Lost Causes, because she had an inkling that her daughter would need some help.
